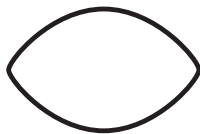


Do You Carry the Ball?

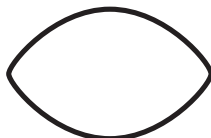
Decide if you need to carry over in each problem. Then solve the problem.

<p>Example:</p> $\begin{array}{r} 56 \\ +23 \\ \hline \end{array}$ <p><u>79</u></p>	<p>You <u>do not</u> need to carry over. 6 + 3 = 9 ones.</p>	<p>Example:</p> $\begin{array}{r} 56 \\ +24 \\ \hline \end{array}$ <p><u>80</u></p>	<p>You <u>do</u> need to carry over. 6 + 4 = 1 ten, so you carry it over to the tens column.</p>
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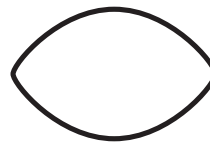

CJ Says:



Let your child group small objects to solve these addition problems. For 26 + 37, have your child use craft sticks to solve the problem. Emphasize adding the ones first. Guide your child into regrouping (carrying) the 6 and 7 ones into 1 ten and 3 ones before continuing on with her problem. Repeat this procedure with other problems until you are confident that your young learner understands this process.
